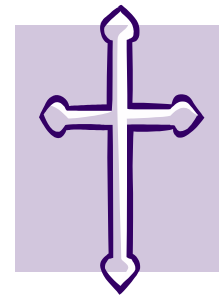

As Lent begins, our attention is drawn to that temptation within each of us to become like God--we want control, power, and answers to all of life's difficult questions. As communities of faith, we are given this season of repentance so that we can join our hearts with others on the difficult journey of conversion. We look to God and to one another for strength against temptation.

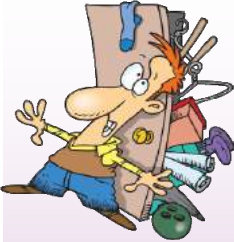

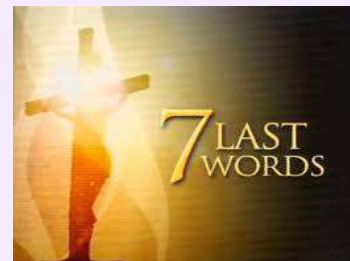

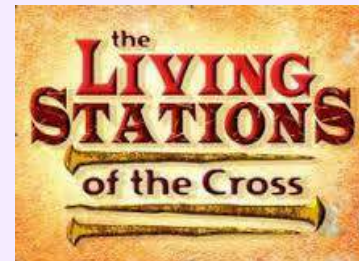

Capital Campaign Update 2-22-17

During the months of December and January, we collected \$63,491.00 in Capital Campaign contributions. We also completed several projects. In December, we rebuilt all the canister lights in the church to accept energy-efficient LED light bulbs. This will help in several ways. First, we will experience reduced energy costs; secondly, we will benefit from the longer life of the LED bulbs with reduced expenses from frequent bulb replacement. This was the first step in converting all of our lighting to high-efficiency LED bulbs.

During December we also repaired the plumbing in the Parish Office Building. Many of the old pipes had rotted, causing limited use of the facilities. This was the first step in the renovation of the 49-year-old building.

In January we replaced the HVAC controls in the classroom building. Prior to this update not all of the controls were functioning, and we had no capability of managing temperature in the classrooms. With the new control system, the classrooms will be more comfortable, as we will be able to program the controls, which will result in more energy efficiency.

Spring Capital Campaign projects include tile replacement in the entryways of the church narthex, tuck pointing repairs to the classroom building, and repaving the east and west parking lots.
